From 1976 to 1985, Francine Rivers had a successful writing career in the general market, and her books were awarded or nominated for numerous awards and prizes. Although raised in a religious home, Francine did not truly encounter Christ until later in life when she was already a wife, mother of three, and an established romance novelist. Shortly after becoming a Christian in 1986, Francine wrote ***Redeeming Love*** as her statement of faith. This retelling of the biblical story of Gomer and Hosea set during the time of the California Gold Rush is now considered by many to be a classic work of Christian fiction. Since ***Redeeming Love***, Francine has published numerous novels with Christian themes—all bestsellers—and she has continued to win both industry acclaim and reader loyalty around the globe. Francine uses her writing to draw closer to the Lord, and that through her work, she might worship and praise Jesus for all He has done and is doing in her life.

Our library has several of Francine's novels, including her latest, ***The Lady's Mind***. Please visit out us on Sunday mornings between 8:45-9:00 a.m. or weekdays during regular business hours to check out Francine's or other great writer's novels.
